Welcome to PIVET Medical Centre

In order to provide you with the best medical and nursing care, PIVET will be compiling a detailed personal, general health and clinical profile, starting from your initial consult. This also involves a physical examination on both partners during the consult appointment.

As part of the clinical assessment, our Doctors will ask you to have initial blood tests after your consultation. We do ask that you please set aside 1 – 2 hours of your time for this visit, to allow our Doctors to spend quality time with you and to attend to the necessary tests.

During this consult, the Doctor will review past history i.e.: *prior treatment, operations, blood tests etc.*, therefore we do ask that you please bring along any relevant history that may assist PIVET with this process.

As part of your initial investigations, PIVET will require you to undergo an ultrasound scan, which is performed after the initial consult at SKG Radiology. You will be given the necessary information and a PIVET referral to arrange for this ultrasound during your consult with the Doctor. Please schedule and attend your ultrasound appointment prior to PIVET consults.

Following your initial consult, PIVET requires patients to attend a further review consult where the Doctor will discuss the results of the tests performed during your initial consult. At the time of your review consult, the doctor will also discuss the best course of treatment to be undertaken.

PLEASE NOTE: PIVET REQUIRES CONFIRMATION AND/OR CANCELATION OF YOUR APPOINTMENT AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR CONSULT DATE

Blood test results may take up to two (2) weeks to being reported to PIVET. A follow-up consult with the Doctor will be scheduled to discuss these results.

For couples attending PIVET for fertility appointments, we do ask that both partners be present, where possible.

As PIVET is a specialist clinic, we do require all patients to present a current referral from your referring Doctor, advising you to visit PIVET. This will also allow you to claim Medicare entitlements for your PIVET consults.

Please complete the enclosed forms and return in the PIVET envelope provided. If you are unable to return the forms via mail, please bring along to your initial consult.

Please provide the following at the time of your initial consult:
