CLINIC UPDATE

1st February 2021

Following the announcement by Premier Mark McGowan on 31 January 2021 of a 5 day lockdown, the following arrangements will apply within the clinic:-

- Upon arrival at the clinic please scan in using the COVID-19 Safe WA app and complete a COVID-19 questionnaire. In addition a temperature check will be carried out.
- As face masks are mandatory outside the home, any person entering the clinic must be wearing a face mask. If you do not have a face mask, we will happily provide one before you enter.
- It is important to sanitise your hands regularly. Hand sanitiser is provided throughout the clinic for your use.
- Patient appointments will be converted to Skype during the lockdown period. Our reception team will contact you to arrange this.
- All current treatment cycles will continue as planned and our nursing staff will contact you directly to provide further information.
- Blood tests & ultrasound scans will proceed as required.
- It is preferable that partners do not accompany patients inside the clinic for blood tests, scans, egg collection or transfers.
- Children will not be allowed into the clinic.
