26th April 2021

Following the announcement by Premier Mark McGowan on 26 April 2021 and the restrictions in place until Friday midnight, 30 April, the following arrangements will apply within the clinic:-

- Upon arrival at the clinic please scan in using the COVID-19 Safe WA app and complete a COVID-19 questionnaire.
- A temperature check will be carried out.
- As face masks are mandatory outside the home, any person entering the clinic must be wearing a face mask. If you do not have a face mask, we will happily provide one before you enter.
- It is important to sanitise your hands regularly. Hand sanitiser is provided throughout the clinic for your use.
- In keeping with the 4sqm rule, the number of patients in the waiting room will be restricted at all times.
- Scheduled clinical appointments will continue at PIVET, however Skype appointments can be arranged if you do not wish to attend the clinic.
- Current treatment cycles will continue as planned. If you have any concerns please do not hesitate to contact our nursing staff.
- Blood tests & ultrasound scans will proceed as required.
- It is preferable that partners do not accompany patients inside the clinic for blood tests, scans, egg collection or transfers.
- Children will not be allowed into the clinic.
