

COVID-19

CLINIC ARRANGEMENTS

25th January 2022

With the increasing numbers of COVID-19 cases, the following arrangements will be put into place in the clinic.

- 1. Upon arrival at the clinic patients will complete a screening form and have a temperature check. Please check in with the COVID-19 SafeWA app.
- 2. At entry patients will need to sanitise their hands and practice social distancing at all times.
- 3. Numbers of patients allowed into the waiting room will be restricted.
- 4. Only initial doctors appointments will be seen in the clinic and both partners should attend.
- 5. No partners, support persons or children will be permitted in the clinic to accompany patients attending for blood tests, scans or treatments.
- 6. All further doctors appointments will be carried out by Skype or Teams.
- 7. The laboratory will carry out telephone consults.
- 8. Semen samples will need to be collected at home and dropped off at the clinic, unless instructed otherwise. Instructions will be provided, and patients will need to collect a specimen collection pack from the clinic.
- 9. Partners will not be allowed to accompany patients for procedures in theatre at Perth Day Surgery Centre.

The management and staff apologise for any inconvenience caused by these changes however these measures are being introduced to protect the safety of all patients and our staff.
